

MEDINA COUNTY CENTRAL PROCESSING FACILITY

Herman Gibans Fodor, Inc. was selected to design a 60,000 square foot materials recovery facility to serve as a prototype for future implementation in various communities throughout the United States.

To enhance the aesthetic of the community, a combination of light brown split face concrete block and beige metal panels with forest green accents was selected. Extensive landscaping further enhances the appearance of the facility.

A second materials recovery facility, based on this prototype design, has recently been completed in Flagstaff, Arizona, and HGF has just completed construction documents for another similar facility in Broadview Heights, Ohio.
