

UNIVERSITY PLACE HEALTH CENTER Mayfield Village, Ohio



Herman Gibans Fodor, Inc. was selected to design a medical office building with future expansion options in Mayfield Village, Ohio. The client required that the new building display elements of traditional architecture similar to those at Cleveland's University Hospital campus.

HGF completed programming and design services for the three story 46,000 square foot building which is designed to accommodate 26,000 square feet of future expansion. The design is determined by the unusual site configuration which resulted in a parallelogram shaped structure.

To be compatible with University Hospital's campus architecture, as well as keep within budget restrictions, traditional brick was used in a contemporary way. In addition, pre-formed metal panels and decorative tiles were used as highlights on the brick facade.
